



Legislator Scorecard for the 2012 Arizona Legislative Session

This legislative session, Planned Parenthood fought diligently for the reproductive rights of all Arizonans. There was commonsense legislation offered that addressed fundamental health care needs, only to have it rejected by anti-choice legislators in favor of extreme legislation preventing women and families from accessing health care.

Legislation we supported:

- ✓ **HB 2331**- This bill would have required hospitals to provide Emergency Contraception (EC) to sexual assault survivors in the emergency room; recognized the duty of pharmacies and providers to stock and dispense EC, and provided for an awareness program to educate Arizonans about EC. **No action was taken on this bill.** **Sponsor: Representative Anna Tovar (LD13).**
- ✓ **HB 2616** – This bill would have required all schools to provide sex education that is medically accurate and comprehensive. **No action was taken on this bill.** **Sponsor: Representative Katie Hobbs (LD15)**

Legislation we opposed:

- ◆ **HB 2036** - (Strike-all) – **20 Week Abortion Ban - Rep. Kimberly Yee.** This bill prohibits abortions post 20 weeks, except in a medical emergency with no exception for health or for a fetal anomaly. Physicians are threatened with criminal and civil penalties as well as unprofessional conduct sanctions and loss of license. The bill requires the use of outdated protocols that are medically unnecessary and costly. **Signed into law 4-12-2012**
- ◆ **HB 2625** – (Strike-all) **Contraceptive Religious Discrimination – Rep. Debbie Lesko.** This bill allows many employers who have a religious objection, to refuse to provide coverage for birth control in their health plans, allowing employers to impose their religious beliefs on to their employees, particularly women. It also allows an employer to discriminate against an employee who has independently obtained birth control. This bill could allow Arizona employers to fire a woman upon finding out that she used birth control for the purpose of preventing pregnancy. **Signed into law 5-11-2012**
- ◆ **HB 2627 - Rep. Debbie Lesko.** This bill excludes Planned Parenthood from eligibility as a qualifying organization for The Working Poor Tax Credit. It **excludes organizations that serve the working poor from qualifying** under the “working poor donation tax credit” program for charitable organizations if they provide abortion care. **Signed into law 4-17-2012**
- ◆ **HB 2800- No Public Funding for Family Planning – Rep. Justin Olson.** This bill attempts to prevent Planned Parenthood from providing services to AHCCCS and Title X patients and prohibits any governmental entity from entering into a contract with or making a grant for, family planning, to any organization that performs abortions. **Signed into law 5-4-2012**
- ◆ **SB1359 – Wrongful Life/Birth - Senator Nancy Barto.** SB1359 protects doctors from fully informing pregnant women of prenatal health issues if such information could lead to an abortion. **Signed into law 4-17-2012**
- ◆ **SB 1009 – (Strike-all) Promote Childbirth and Adoption in Schools – Senator Nancy Barto.** In all instructional programs, public schools must promote childbirth and adoption as preferred options to abortion. **Signed into law 4-12-2012**
